Dear Nepean Hockey Association Member

As you are aware Penrith District Hockey Association (PDHA) and Western Districts Women's Hockey Association (WDWHA) have begun the process of amalgamation. With a view towards giving you an understanding of the process, we wish to provide the following information:-

A Joint Management Committee (JMC) has been formed consisting of four representatives from each Association. These eight officers are Jennifer Davis, Cheryl Dollin, Sandra Green and Jennifer O'Toole from Western Districts along with Michael Hughes, Kieran Knowles, Noelene Knowles and Vince Pace from Penrith District. The JMC has met on three occasions since 22nd March and will continue to meet on a regular basis throughout the 2010 season. Minutes of these meetings and all subsequent meetings will be made available to every member.

The charter of the JMC is to -

- a. Administer all activities relating to Hockey in the Nepean area in 2010 and
- b. Oversee the amalgamation process.

These functions include management of all representative teams, organizing the 2010 men's, women's and junior competitions, administration of field hire, all financial issues, management and operation of the canteen, registration with Hockey NSW, all publicity relating to Hockey in the Nepean area and dealing with any other Hockey related issues which may arise throughout the year.

All players and officials are automatically members of Nepean Hockey Association as both PDHA and WDWHA are in the process of winding down and will no longer be running competitions.

While all members of the JMC are only too happy to answer your questions, please be mindful that Vince Pace has been elected Correspondence Secretary and as such we would appreciate all emails and correspondence to be directed to him at one of the above addresses. In relation to financial queries, Michael Hughes has been given the job of Financial Controller and as such will be able to provide any financial information. He can also be contacted via the email address above or by mail to the PO Box. Most weekends, there will be at least one member of the JMC available at the fields should any urgent matters arise.

This amalgamation is for the betterment of hockey in the area and has been endorsed by both Associations along with Hockey NSW. Please understand that it is only with the full co-operation of all parties that the amalgamation will be a success.
